

Thank you for your interest in the Dallastown Foundation Scholarship Committee (DFSC) program.

THE ONLINE APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED BY MONDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2021.

Student Eligibility and Scholarship Guidelines:

- Applicant must complete the application entirely.
- Applicant must be planning to attend a post-secondary program at an accredited institution.
 - For example: a 2-year, 4-year, technical or trade school
- Activities cannot be entered in more than one category.
 - For example, school activities cannot also be entered as skill enrichment
- Past and continued appropriate behavior, both in and out of school
- Financial need is not a criterion for DFSC scholarships.
- The data provided is entered into a program that scores, assigns points, and generates a list of recipients.
- The criteria for these awards include involvement, initiative and improvement in the defined categories listed below.
 - 50% Academic Performance
 30% Weighted GPA
 20% Yearly improvement of GPA from Grade 9 to 12
 - 25% School Activities & Attendance (Time commitment provided by coach / advisor)
 - 25% Volunteerism / Skill Enrichment / Work Experience (Non-school related activity, scouts, private instruction, sports clubs, employment)

Online Application / Activity History: This portion can only be submitted online. The application must be completed in its entirety during ONE session. Information can NOT be saved and completed at a later time. To prepare your information, a review of the application WORKSHEET is recommended prior to filling out the online application.

High school guidance counselors will provide the data for Academic Performance and Attendance.

Applicants will be notified in April whether or not they will be receiving a scholarship.

Applicants could also be eligible for scholarship awards at varying amounts through the York County Community Foundation and other private endowments.
